Is Hell A Real Place?

The average Christian possesses very little, if any, reality of hell. For whatever reason, this is one topic people would rather avoid. As Christians there should be no fear in discussing such an important subject. After all, those who have accepted Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, will spend eternity with our heavenly Father. That's enough to make one stop and take a praise break!

On the other hand, we must take a moment to reflect on the state of the unsaved. The unsaved are those who have not received Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. This article is not to incite fear but to inform. Let's see what the Bible says about hell!

God has given us an opportunity to decide. One passage of scripture that most are familiar with is John 3:16. "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life (John 3:16)." This verse of scripture is used to introduces individuals to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

First and foremost, "hell" is a real place. God did not make hell for people. The following scriptures reveals this fact. "Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels (Matthew 25:41)." Hell was for Satan (the Devil) and those angels who rebelled against God. God is merciful and longsuffering toward us. The Bible says "The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance (2 Peter 3:9)." It is important to repeat the fact that God is loving, merciful, and gracious toward us (Romans 5:8).

On the other hand, God must punish disobedience and rebellion. "For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment (2 Peter 2:4)" Some of the angels who disobeyed God were instantly cast into hell. This does not mean that all fallen angels are in hell. There is a specific group who were especially evil who received this punishment.

Perhaps one of the clearest illustrations of eternal punishment lies in the story of Lazarus and the Rich Man (Luke 16:19-310). Take some time to read these passages for yourself.

Is Hell A Real Place?

The story told by Jesus Christ is clear and concise regarding the separation between the righteous and the wicked. The article is to inform you that we must make the right decision regarding eternity. The reality is that we have a short time here on earth. There's another sobering story in the Bible that gives an insight illustration of hell (Numbers 16:25-33). It reveals how God dealt with rebellion in the Old Testament. Remember, the Holy Bible is the inspired and inerrant Word of God (2 Peter 1:20-21). The Holy Bible is given to us to teach us the proper way to conduct ourselves (1 Corinthians 10:11-12). Everything in the Bible was not inspired by God but He allowed these stories as an example.

Jesus told his listeners"....And if thy hand offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to go into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched: where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched (Mark 9:43-46)." Based on Jesus' description, hell is real!

The goal in writing this article is to increase our understanding of hell. We serve a God of love and mercy (John 3:16; Romans 5:8; 1 John 4:19; Ephesians 2:8-9). It's imperative to get the message. Hell is a real place!

The Prayer Room

Prayer is important! The Bible says we should always pray (1 Thessalonians 5:17). Prayer is an important communication tool we use to interact with heaven. God intervenes on behalf of His people through prayer. It is through prayer that God brings about change in the life of His people!


Come expecting a move from God in a way that you have not encountered before. Get ready because there's going to be a "Word" from the Lord just for you! Invite someone who needs a Word!
