Seed of the Woman

If you know the Bible to any degree, then you know Satan has always targeted the youth. He seeks to corrupt the youth early. This is especially true of males. Why? Satan's quest to corrupt the youth began in the Garden of Eden.

The three contributors, who participated the Fall in the Garden of Eden were Adam, Eve, and the serpent (Satan). Immediately after the Fall of Man, God pronounced judgment on each contributor. Adam disobeyed God; Eve was deceived, and the serpent (Satan) initiated the treasonous act against God.

Let's pick this up after the Fall! "And the Lord God said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou art cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life:" (Genesis 3:14). The serpent, for whatever reason was a co-conspirator which allowed Satan to instigate man's rebellion against God.

God judged Eve! God also pronounced the way of deliverance, and ultimately, the salvation of man. "And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel" (Genesis 3:15). I want to take a moment to provide some this

commentary on this verse.

God comments on the woman's "seed!" This is important to note because women do possess seed. If you know your biology, women do not produce seed. The "seed" comes from the man. This is important because when the Bible refers to "her seed" it points to the birth of Jesus Christ (Matthew 1:18-25; Luke 1:30-38). The main point I want to make is the "seed" of the woman refers to a male child! Satan learned through God's prophetic "Word" that his challenge would come from a man.

After Adam committed high treason against God, he was no longer sin free. The sin nature is what separates man from God. God created men and women to reflect His glory and to experience fellowship. That was disrupted in the Garden of Eden! Through Adam's sin, all of creation was corrupted (Romans 8:19-22). The sin nature is passed to the child through the "seed" of the father! Every human, conceived after the Fall of Man would be born with a sin nature (Romans 5:12-19). This includes you and me! We were born with a sin nature. We were born spiritually dead and separated from God (Romans 3:23;6:23).

Seed of the Woman

Jesus Christ is the only Person who was born sinless! Jesus came to bring us back into fellowship with God (2 Corinthians 5:18-19).
